2195-K]**

Dear Mr. Horst:

During the period January 1 – June 30, 2005, Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) did not conduct open burn activities authorized under air quality permits 2195-J [TA-11 Wood and Fuel Fire Test Site and TA-16 Flash Pad] and 2195-K [DX TA-36 Sled Track]. Section 5(a) of these permits requires LANL to submit a semi-annual Open Burn Report concurrent with our semi-annual Title V reports. LANL is submitting this letter to satisfy permit condition 5(a).

During this period, LANL did conduct open burning on RCRA material under open burn permit TA-16-OB-2003. These activities will be summarized in our annual Fire Activity Report which is required by permit TA-16-OB-2003.
