Subject: Request for Spinner Logging at Water-Supply Well PM-2 and Agreement for Payment of Services

Dear Mr. Glasgow:

This letter serves to request that Los Alamos County (the County) conduct spinner-log tests in the County's water-supply well PM-2 as part of the upcoming well-maintenance efforts planned in December and January, 2007. The Laboratory can benefit greatly from the data obtained from the spinner-log tests and appreciates the County's efforts to coordinate the test within the maintenance period.

The Laboratory has reviewed and agrees with the cost estimate provided by the County's drilling contractor, Layne Christensen Company. Please proceed with implementation of the spinner-log tests. Although not specifically noted in the cost proposal, it is assumed that the cost estimate includes a field summary report that includes the data, print-outs of the spinner logs, and details of the test and any information that would be useful for interpretation of the log data.

The Laboratory will reimburse the County via billing in the monthly utility bill following completion of the tests. The Laboratory agrees to pay up to and not exceeding \$75,000. This amount exceeds the Layne Western estimate by approximately \$10,000 to allow for additional work that the Laboratory may request real-time during the mobilization dependent on the findings of the tests.
