The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Periodic Monitoring Report for Pajarito Watershed, June 1 – June 24, 2010* dated November 2010 and referenced by LA-UR-10-6043 / EP2010-0395 (Report). NMED provides the following comment.

Comment. Table C-2 Pajarito Analytical Results, page C-133:

The Report indicates a detection of chloromethane at $0.39 \mu g/L$ in the sample collected from well R-19, Port 232 on June 2, 2010. The detection is indicated as "EQB" in the Field QC Type column. The acronym EQB is not explained in the list of symbols, abbreviations and acronyms used in Appendix C. The Permittees must describe all

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symbols, abbreviations and acronyms used in future reports.
