EXTENSION REQUESTS FOR THE WELL EVALUATION AND NETWORK RECOMMENDATIONS STUDY REPORT FOR TECHNICAL AREA 16 AND UPPER WATER CANYON WATERSHED AND THE PUMP TEST REPORT FOR WELL CDV-16-4IP LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY EPA ID#NM0890010515 HWB-LANL-MISC-GW

Dear Messrs. Rael and Graham:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Extension Requests for the Well Evaluation and Network Recommendations Study Report for Technical Area 16 and Upper Water Canyon Watershed and the Pump Test Report for Well CdV-16-4ip* (Request) dated March 7, 2011 and referenced by EP2011-0101.

With reference to the extension request for the Permittees' submittal of Well Evaluation and Network Recommendations Study Report for Technical Area 16 and Upper Water Canyon Watershed (Report), the Request states that additional time is needed to deliver a complete and defensible Report. Specifically, a postponement of the submittal of the Messrs. Rael and Graham March 16, 2011 Page 2

Report from the original due date of July 1, 2011 to December 15, 2011 is needed so that the Permittees can adequately compile, assess, and evaluate all pertinent information and results that will be provided in the Water Canyon and Cañon de Valle watershed investigation report (due August 31, 2011), and the reliability assessments of intermediate well R-47i (due March 30, 2011) and multiscreened Westbay wells R-26, CdV-R-15-3, and CdV-R-37-2 (due July 29, 2011).

The Permittees' second extension request is directed at postponing the submittal of the CdV-16-4i Pump Test Report (Test Report) from its original due date of March 27, 2011 to May 26, 2011. As stated in the Request, the delay in the submittal of the Test Report is due to unavoidable problems with construction, development, and aquifer testing at nearby regional aquifer well R-63 that have interfered with the work at CdV-16-4i.

The Permittees have shown good cause for the extension requests. NMED therefore grants them as requested. The aforementioned Report and Test Report are due no later than **December 15, 2011** and **May 26, 2011**, respectively.
