The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Notification of Demolition Activities for Third Quarter 2011*, dated July 18, 2011 and referenced by ENV-RCRA-11-0130/LAUR-11-03747.

Several Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs) are located within 50 ft. of the buildings proposed for demolition. The investigations are not complete at several of these sites; some sites are, or would be, proposed for further investigation and at some of the sites investigations were delayed because of accessibility issues. Several of the sampling locations proposed in the approved work plans are adjacent to the buildings scheduled for demolition. The Permittees must document the demolition activities to ensure that there are no adverse impacts to sites where investigations are not complete.

Pursuant to Section 1.17.3 of the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Permit (Permit), NMED hereby requires notice of demolition 30 days prior to the commencement of demolition activities, for the following structures:
