Subject: Las Conchas Wildfire Effects and Mitigation Actions in Affected Canyons

Dear Mr. Kieling:

Enclosed please find two hard copies with electronic files of the Las Conchas Wildfire Effects and Mitigation Actions in Affected Canyons.

The Las Conchas wildfire started on June 26, 2011, in the Jemez Mountains, approximately 10 mi west of Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory). Although the fire did not burn on Laboratory property, it did burn the upper portions of three of the major watersheds on Laboratory property: the Los Alamos Canyon, Pajarito Canyon, and Water Canyon watersheds. In response to this increased flood risk, the Laboratory implemented mitigation actions during and after the fire to lessen the potential for flood damage. Although these efforts were effective in reducing the impacts of floods, several heavy rainfall events in late August 2011 resulted in flooding significant enough to result in damage to Laboratory structures. This report identifies the effects of the wildfire and subsequent flooding on the Laboratory, describes completed mitigation actions, and identifies major issues of concern.
