The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Request for Extension to Submit the Summary Report for the Two-Phase Purge Test for Regional Aquifer Well R-29* (Report) dated October 6, 2011 and referenced by EP2011-0338.

The Permittees request the extension to submit the Report due to the need to focus on removal of transuranic (TRU) waste from Technical Area (TA) 54 to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant, located in Eddy County, New Mexico. The need to remove TRU waste stored at TA-54 is aligned with Governor Martinez' policy to prioritize groundwater and surface water protection and accelerate the removal of TRU waste stored at Los Alamos National Laboratory.

The Permittees stated cause for the requested time extension is acceptable. The submittal date for the Report is hereby postponed from December 21, 2011 to **December 21, 2013**, as requested. The results of sampling of well R-29 indicate that the data cannot be considered to be reliable until further testing is completed. The Permittees must notify NMED, within 30 days of receipt of such information, should funds become available in the future that allow for the purge test to be implemented and the Report submitted prior to December 21, 2013.
