EXTENSION REQUEST FOR SUBMITTAL OF THE PHASE III INVESTIGATION REPORT FOR DP SITE AGGREGATE AREA LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY EPA ID#NM0890010515 HWB-LANL-11-033

Dear Messrs. Rael and Graham:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Request for Extension to Submit the Phase III Investigation Report for DP Site Aggregate Area* (Request) dated December 2, 2011 and referenced by EP2011-0395.

The Permittees request the extension to submit the investigation report for DP Site Aggregate Area at Technical Area (TA) 21 due to the need to focus on removal of transuranic (TRU) waste from TA-54 to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant, located in Eddy County, New Mexico. The need to remove TRU waste stored at TA-54 is aligned with Governor Martinez' policy to prioritize groundwater and surface water protection and accelerate the removal of TRU waste stored at Los Alamos National Laboratory.

The Permittees stated cause for the requested time extension is acceptable. The submittal of the Phase III Investigation Report for DP Site Aggregate Area is hereby postponed from April 20, 2012 to April 20, 2014, as requested. NMED may re-evaluate the need for this extension based on the Permittees' progress in accelerating the removal of TRU waste from TA-54 or if new information arises that indicates that contaminant concentrations are increasing in the subsurface beneath TA-21. The Permittees must notify NMED, within 30 days of receipt of such information, should funds become available in the future that allow the investigation report to be completed prior to April 20, 2014.
