Dear Messrs. Rael and Graham:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Work Plan for a Tracer Test at Consolidated Unit 16-021(c)-99, Technical Area 16* (Plan) dated January 2012 and referenced by EP2012-0017.

NMED has reviewed the Plan and hereby issues this Approval with the following modifications.

- 1. The Permittees must complete the laboratory column testing of prospective tracer compounds, finalize the list of tracer compounds selected for deployment, and submit the results of laboratory column testing and the list of tracer compounds selected for deployment to NMED no later than **August 31, 2012**.
- 2. The Permittees must secure all necessary permits and deploy tracers no later than **October 15, 2012**. The Permittees must notify NMED at least fifteen (15) calendar days prior to tracer deployment.

3. The Permittees must include all tracer monitoring data in periodic monitoring reports for the TA-16 260 Outfall Monitoring Group.
