Dear Messrs. Maggiore and Mousseau:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Request for Extension to Submit the Response to the Notice of Disapproval for the Investigation Report for Cañon de Valle Aggregate Area, Technical Area 14 and* [Investigation Report] *Revision 1* (Response) dated November 7, 2012 and referenced by EP2012-0228.

The Permittees request the extension to submit the Response due to their re-allocation of resources to the shipment of transuranic (TRU) waste stored at Technical Area (TA) 54 to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant, located in Eddy County, New Mexico and due to uncertainties in funding levels for the current federal fiscal year (FFY13). The submittal

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date for the Response has been changed from April 30, 2013 to **July 31, 2013**, as requested.

NMED notes that this is the second extension requested by the Permittees to submit this Response from the original due date of July 31, 2012. NMED is concerned over delays that affect the progress of corrective action; however, NMED understands the current uncertainties associated with the allocation of DOE resources to LANS to fund corrective action at the laboratory. The Permittees must notify NMED, within seven days of receipt of such information, should funds become available in the future that allow for the Response to be submitted prior to July 31, 2013. If funding becomes available, NMED may re-evaluate the deadline for completion of this project.
