The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received notice from the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration and the Los Alamos National Security LLC, collectively the "Permittees" dated November 5, 2012 of a Class 1 modification to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit). The modification includes an address change in Attachment D and corrections to typographical errors in Part 2.

NMED has review the permit modification request and concurs that these changes are Class 1 modification in accordance with 20.4.1.900 NMAC, incorporating 40 CFR 270.42(a). NMED has further determined that the Permittee has noticed this Permit notification in accordance with 20.4.1.900 NMAC incorporating 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(i) and (ii). The modifications are to be

If you disagree with the fees assessed you may notify NMED in writing at the address above of your intent to appeal the invoice(s) under the provisions of 20.4.2.302 NMAC.
