Dear Messrs. Maggiore and Mousseau:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Notification of Force Majeure – Flood Event of September 2013* (Notification), dated September 25, 2013 and referenced by EP2013-0229. In accordance with Section III.H.3 of the March 1, 2005 Compliance Order on Consent (Consent Order), the Permittees provided an email notification to NMED on September 16, 2013.

The Permittees state in the Notification that during the week of September 10, 2013, rainfall totals in some areas of the Laboratory exceeded 7-inches. These storms included record runoff, flooding, and erosion. The Permittees estimate that 75% of canyon access roads are damaged and impassable to vehicles. Assessments of damage to infrastructure and equipment are ongoing.

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The Permittees anticipate significant delays in the completion of the scope of work for the Sandia Canyon grade-control structure (SCGS) project. Extensive repairs, regrading, and replanting will be required.

This correspondence constitutes written notice of NMED's agreement under Section III.H.3 of the Consent Order that a force majeure event has occurred. NMED agrees that the Permittees did not complete the SCGS on schedule. The Permittees submitted the SCGS completion report on December 19, 2013.
