Dear Mr. Kieling:

Enclosed please find two hard copies with electronic files of Los Alamos National Laboratory's (the Laboratory's) response to the notice of disapproval (NOD) for the Investigation Report for Area of Concern 01-007(k) in the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area, Revision 1 of the report, and a crosswalk table of comment responses and report revisions.

Based on discussions during a July 31, 2014, meeting between Laboratory and New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) personnel, the report has been revised to present a more comprehensive and appropriate lines of evidence explaining why the polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) detected at the site are not site-related. Because NMED has expressed concern associated with potential risks of the PAHs detected at Area of Concern 01-007(k), results of the risk-screening evaluation have been provided in the response to the NOD, indicating no unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.

In addition, per the July 31, 2014, meeting, the text identifying inorganic chemicals of potential concern has been revised to present the lines of evidence (including comparisons with the maximum background concentrations) for eliminating or retaining some inorganic chemicals.
