Dear Mr. Kieling:

In accordance with Section VII.E.6.b of the Compliance Order on Consent (the Consent Order), the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) are requesting a Certificate of Completion without Controls for the following area of concern (AOC) within the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area:

AOC 01-007(k), Suspected Subsurface Soil Contamination

AOC 01-007(k) was recommended for corrective action complete without controls in the report titled Investigation Report for Area of Concern 01-007(k) in the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area, Revision 1 (LA-UR-14-28893/EP2014-0471) (hereafter, the IR). The IR confirms the nature and extent of contamination have been defined, and/or no further sampling for extent is warranted at AOC 01-007(k). In addition, the IR demonstrates that AOC 01-007(k) poses no unacceptable risk or dose to human health under the industrial, construction worker, and residential scenarios and poses no potential risk to ecological receptors. Therefore, neither site controls nor additional future actions under the Consent Order are necessary at this site.

The IR was approved by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) in its letter, Approval, Investigation Report for Area of Concern 01-007(k) in the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area (HWB-LANL-14-018), dated January 5, 2015. NMED's approval letter stated that AOC 01-007(k) is "appropriate for corrective action complete without controls."
