Subject: Transmittal of Class 1 Permit Modification to Update a Figure in Permit Attachment G.18, in the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, EPA ID No. NM0890010515

The purpose of this letter is to submit a Class 1 permit modification to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit issued to the Department of Energy and Los Alamos National Security, LLC (DOE/LANS) in November 2010. The permit modification provides revisions to a figure in Permit Attachment G.18.

Please note that the proposed Permit Modification (contained in the envelope marked “UCNI”) contains Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information (UCNI) as defined pursuant to federal law. The UCNI figure, which is submitted as confidential information in compliance with 40 CFR § 270.12 requirements, is for the use of the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Bureau (NMED-HWB) only and must be used and stored appropriately according to Atomic Energy Act Section 148 requirement. If there are any questions as to what type of arrangements are required for federally-compliant storage or management of UCNI information, please contact the Permittees.

Technical Area (TA) 55, Building 4, Room B40 is a permitted unit used to store containers of hazardous and mixed waste that may contain liquids. Also, included in the unit are “waste storage cabinets” as described in the attached UCNI figure. This proposed modification includes the request to remove two of the waste storage cabinets as well as an update to reflect this change in Figure G.18-1. The two cabinets

proposed for removal were used to store hazardous waste and will be removed and disposed of upon approval of this proposed permit modification request and in accordance with the requirements set forth in Permit Attachment G.18, Section 5.3.1.

The proposed modification has been prepared in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations [CFR], Title 40 (40 CFR) § 270.42(a)(2) and Permit Section 3.1(3).

This permit modification package includes this transmittal letter and two enclosures. Enclosure 1 contains a replacement UCNI figure for Attachment G.18 of the Permit. Enclosure 2 contains a signed certification page. Three hard copies and one electronic copy (which omits UCNI information) of this submittal will be delivered to the NMED-HWB. Enclosure 1 will be provided to the NMED-HWB in hard copy and will not be included in the distribution.

Upon approval of this Class 1 permit modification, the modification will be put into effect and notice will be sent to the NMED-HWB maintained LANL facility mailing list in accordance with 40 CFR §270.42(a)(1)(ii) within ninety days of the approval of this permit modification.


