The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively the Respondents) *Supplemental Environmental Project, Storm Water Engineering Structure Work Plan Regarding Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order HWB-14-20, Addendum 2* (Addendum 2) referenced by ADESH-16-214/LAUR-16-29160, dated December 12, 2016. The work plan was developed pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order signed between the NMED and the Respondents on January 22, 2016 to resolve NMED Compliance Order HWB-14-20 issued to the Respondents on December 6, 2014.

Paragraph 39 of the Stipulated Final Order requires that the DOE expend \$7.5 million to design and install engineering structures in canyons in and around the Los Alamos National Laboratory to slow storm water flow and decrease sediment load to improve water quality in the area,

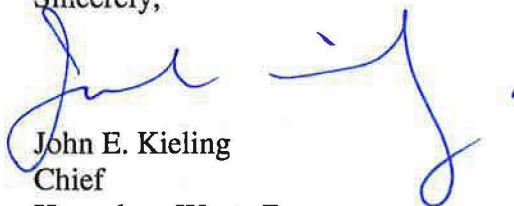
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allowing surface water management at a watershed scale, and requires the submittal of Addendum 2, a proposed Storm Water Engineering Structure Work Plan, to NMED for review and approval.

Addendum 2 describes the purpose of the project, justification for the selection of subprojects, locations of the proposed engineering structures, and schedule of implementation of the subprojects.
