The purpose of this letter is to report on hazardous waste treatability studies for calendar year (CY) 2017 for the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), EPA ID NM0890010515. Reporting of treatability studies conducted during the previous calendar year is required annually by New Mexico Administrative Code, Title 20, Chapter 4, Part 1, Section 200 (20.4.1.200 NMAC) as revised March 1, 2009, (incorporating Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations [40 CFR] § 261.4(f)(9)).

There were no treatability studies conducted at LANL during CY 2017 and there are no new treatability studies proposed for CY 2018. In the event that treatability studies are proposed for this year, a notice of intent to conduct a study will be prepared and submitted to your office at least 45 days prior to beginning the study, as required by 20.4.1.200 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR § 261.4(f)(1)).

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
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
