Dear Messrs. Goodrum and Mairson:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) National Nuclear Security Administration, Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) and the Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Technical Area 63 Transuranic Waste Facility Soil Vapor Monitoring System Report*, *Quarter 3* Report dated and received June 28, 2018, and referenced by EPC-DO-18-245 and LA-UR-18-25633.

Soil vapor monitoring was conducted at Technical Area 63 Transuranic Waste Facility on May 1, 2018, for the third quarter of the monitoring year. The Report indicates that vapor concentrations from the five vapor monitoring wells (VMWs), 1 through 5, did not exceed soil-gas screening levels (SGSLs) for the identified constituents in Tables 3.14.3.1, 3.14.3.2, and 3.14.3.3 of Part 3 of the Permit. NMED has completed review of the Report and has no comments.

NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2), NMAC. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.F NMAC require the assessment of fees. Payment is normally due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. However, because NMED currently maintains a supplemental fee agreement with the Permittees for State fiscal year 2019, and the Permittees transmitted payment of supplemental fees, the fee invoice has been effectively paid under these supplemental fees.
